<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ If Scout attended summer camp in both 2010 and 2011, the second summer camp experience will count as two additional nights of camping. ✓ A second consecutive week of summer camp is considered a continuation of the first week, and will not count towards the Scout's camping requirement. ✓ Additional high adventure camps (Porcupine Mountains, Philmont, etc.) will count as 2 nights of camping if Scout has already fulfilled the long-term camping requirement through summer camp. ✓ All eligibility forms must be completed, approved by the Scoutmaster, and returned to Mr. Carden no later than Friday, Jan. 20th in order for the Scout to be eligible for election. [Note that there is no troop meeting on Jan 16th]

OA Eligibility Requirements
Hold the BSA First Class rank or higher
Have experienced 15 days and nights of Boy Scout camping during the two-year period prior to the election. The 15 days and nights must include one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of six consecutive days and five nights of resident camping. The balance of the camping must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps.
