MEMORIAL DAY PARADE NEXT WEEK

Just a reminder that **ALL** Scouts are expected to join in the Wheaton American Legion Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 30th! We will meet at the Bandshell in Memorial Park at 9:30 A.M. Parade starts at 10:00 A.M. The March is about 45 minutes long, but "step off" time varies for marching units. Scouts marching with their band should let the S.P.L. know as that will "count" for point totals in Inter Patrol Competition (I.P.C.)

The Troop holds a Family Picnic in Memorial Park after the parade. Start time is 12 noon. Class B. Separate flyer with details and RSVP info.

Family Members: Please note – as this is a Memorial Parade (vs. a celebratory parade) honoring service personnel killed in action, we ask you to refrain from calling to or trying to elicit a response from your Scout. The Scouts are happy you are proud of them and that you want to let them know that, but please do this AFTER the parade, not by hooting at your Scout from the sidelines.
